**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**1. ALL BAKED GOODS WILL NEED A RECIPE OR LIST OF INGREDIENTS ATTACHED TO ENTRY**

- 2. All items must be placed for display on Tuesday, August 8th between 8-9 A.M.
- 3. **Judging will start at 11:00 A.M.**
- 4. Official release time is Sunday, August 13th between 7-8 P.M.
- 5. First and Second Place Cakes and Pies will be auctioned off prior to the Queen's Contest.
- 6. **All pies, cakes, quick breads, yeast breads and cookies must be made from scratch and prepared by exhibitor. NO BOX CAKE MIXES in Classes II through VI**
- 7. All cakes, cake frostings and decorations must be edible.
- 8. All cakes must be displayed on foiled cardboard, not to exceed 1" past cake or in disposable foil cake pan. No cake plates of any kind.
- 9. All cakes and quick breads must be covered with clear wrap or in clear Ziploc plastic bags.
- 10. Cakes can be either 8" or 9" round, or 9 x 13 rectangle.
- 11. One slice of each cake will be on display for the duration of the fair.
- 12. All pies must be in 8" or 9" foil pans only. Displayed in a clear Ziploc bag
- 13. No custard or cream pies will be permitted.
- 14. One slice of each pie and a 1/2 loaf of each quick bread will be on display for the duration of the fair.
- 15. **Three (3) cookies** will be displayed on a paper plate & in a clear Ziploc plastic bag.
- 16. A cookie recipe cannot be entered in more than one cookie category.
- 17. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per category.
- 18. Entries will be judged on appearance, texture, flavor and aroma.

**19. NEW THIS YEAR—MUST SUPPLY YOUR OWN CLEAR ZIPLOC BAGS**

**CLASS I— ENHANCED CAKE MIX (Boxed Mix)**

**Start with a boxed cake mix and embellish the recipe to create a dessert.** Cakes can be any variety. Cakes cannot be just the cake mix baked and frosted. Recipe must be included.

- 1. 8" or 9" Round, 8" or 9" Square, 9x13 Rectangle, or Bundt
- 2. Cupcakes (3)
- 3. Cookies (3)

- 3. Entries will be judged on the cookie as well as the creativity of the container.
- 4. Entries may be picked up between 7-8 P.M. on Sunday, August 13, 2017.
- 5. Premiums will be: 1st—\$10.00; 2nd—\$5.00; 3rd—\$3.00

**OPEN CLASS SHOW  
RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE  
ERIE COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY**

**General Information**

- BE SURE TO READ:** (1) All rules imposed by the Erie County Agricultural Society; (2) All rules imposed by the State of Ohio; (3) All specific instructions under the department in which you wish to enter; (4) The summary of rules on the entry form.
- Questions which arise will be answered by the department superintendents.
- The Erie County Fair Board reserves the sole and absolute right to construe its own rules and regulations and to determine arbitrarily on matters and differences in regard thereto, from which there is no appeal.
- Security and Police officers are on duty on the grounds during the continuance of the Fair. The Erie County Fair Board is not and will not be responsible for damage, loss, or accident that may occur. Exhibitors are requested to give attention to their items during the Fair.**
- Disrespect by an exhibitor or agent toward officials, or any misrepresentation, in regard to entries in any department either by statements made or facts omitted, will render the entry ineligible to compete, and no premium will be paid.
- Competition is open to all counties in Ohio.
- All open class exhibitors must hold a membership ticket, season ticket, or youth wristband.**
- All entries must be made in the name of the owner of the article.
- Entries should be recorded on forms provided and mailed to the Erie County Agricultural Society, PO Box 2436, Sandusky, Ohio, 44870.
- The closing date of all entries for each department will be 6 p.m., July 28, 2017
- All mail in entries in all departments must be postmarked no later than July 28, 2017. There will be no exceptions to this rule.**
- The exhibitor must fill out the entry form completely. This includes designating the department; class; and description of the item. **The entry form must be signed by the exhibitor.**
- When the entry of an item is recorded in the books of the Secretary, tags will be given a number and class which are to be placed on the item. Once the item has been entered, no changes in the entry will be permitted, unless it can be shown that a mistake has been made.

- Superintendent has the right to change entry to a more appropriate category if needed.
- Every item for competition must be placed on display On Monday, August 7, 2017 between 5-8 p.m. except for Antiques and Collectibles starting at 11:00am. The following divisions: Farm & Garden, Floriculture, and Baked Goods. Items for these departments must be placed on display on Tuesday, August 8, 2017 between 8-9 a.m.
- Release time will be from 7-8 p.m. on Sunday, August 13, 2017. **ANY EXHIBITOR REMOVING ITEMS BEFORE RELEASE TIME WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ENTER ANY OPEN CLASS EXHIBITS THE FOLLOWING YEAR. Not responsible for items after 8 p.m.**
- Exhibitor must provide receipt to remove item from display area.
- No interference or communications with the judges will be allowed and any person who by letter or otherwise attempts to influence the decision of the judge, shall forfeit any and all premiums which may be or have been awarded and be ruled out of competition.
- Premiums for all classes are: 1st - \$5.00; 2nd - \$3.00; 3rd - \$1.00.
- PREMIUMS CAN BE PICKED UP ON SUNDAY OF THE FAIR AT THE SR. FAIR BOARD OFFICE.**
- Rosettes and ribbons will be awarded at time of judging or may be picked up in the Sr. Fair Board Office.
- The judges are instructed not to award premiums, unless the items are deemed of worthy merit.
- No person other than members of the Board, who are not competitors, will be allowed to see the entries, or to have access to the judges books after the awards are made.
- If there is any question as to the regularity of any entry, or of the right of any item to compete in any given class, the judges shall report the same to the Superintendent of the Department for adjustment.
- The Fair Board is not responsible for notifying winning exhibitors.
