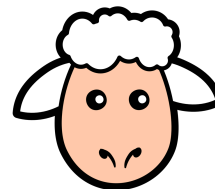

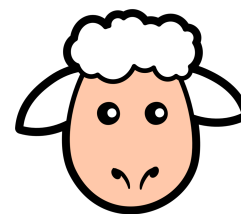

# Erie County Fair Lamb Scramble Rules

## Participants 9-14 years old



### GENERAL RULES

1. Entry fee is \$10.00 per participant, non-refundable.
2. Entries are limited to the first 40 participants.
3. Entry Form and Release Form must be filled out completely and signed by participant AND parent or guardian.
4. Paid participants entered by 8-3-26 will receive a T-shirt the night of the Scramble. T-shirts provided by Scramble Sponsors.
5. Spectator admission to the Scramble will be \$5.00. Only the applicant participating will be admitted free.
6. Check in will begin at 6:00 p.m. on 8-12-26 at the Grandstands.
7. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three in each heat. You do not take possession of the lamb.
8. Closed shoes or boots must be worn while participating. NO flip flops or sandals.
9. Helmets are recommended for all participants.

### HOW THE SCRAMBLE WORKS

1. Participants will be split into heats of 8-12 scramblers.
2. Three lambs will be released into the arena per heat.
3. Participants will be given a rope halter before entering the arena.
4. The halter must be properly placed on the head of the animal in the usual way. It is suggested that all participants become familiar with the proper use of a rope halter and how to place it on the head of a lamb before coming to the Scramble.
5. At NO time can the rope halter be used as a lariat.
6. At NO time can the participant tie the rope halter to any part of their body.
7. If a participant has hold of a lamb, NO other participant will be allowed to touch the lamb until it breaks away.
8. If two or more participants catch the same lamb at the same time, it will be turned loose.
9. The first three participants per heat who secure, properly halter and contain a lamb will be declared a winner by a Beagle Boys referee.
10. Unnecessary roughness will NOT be tolerated; participants will be disqualified and the animal will be set free.
11. All decisions by Beagle Boys judges and referees will be final
